DOCUMENTS

First, arrange the test drive with the seller and bring your driver's license, passport, and proof of insurance.

CHECK FAULTS

Second, check the car for any issues before and after the test drive. Look at the outside and inside of the car and make sure everything works well.

ON THE ROAD

Third, drive the car on various roads and speeds. See how the car performs and how you feel about it.

CAR HISTORY

Fourth, ask the seller about the car's past and present. Get a vehicle history report and a service record if possible.

4

NEGOTIATION

Fifth, negotiate the best deal for the car. Compare the price with other cars online and ask for a lower price

5

ALTERNATELY

You can hire a professional auto broker to help you in the process even if you are outside Germany. Remember, you can also get a pre-buy inspection for any car you want to buy.
